French Arrest 55 in Probes

NICE, Aug. 28—(INS)—Fifty five persons, including 29 city officials, were arrested in Nice today as result of what police termed "the biggest black market scandal in the history of France."

Laurent Maissa, chief of the Nice food ministry, was among those taken into custody. During the past two years, it

was said, a million and a half food cards were sold for 150 francs each. The total take was put in the neighborhood of a quarter billion francs.

Building Booms In Single Month

COLUMBUS, Aug. 28-(UP)-Construction activity in Ohio inereased 44 per cent in June from May and more than 400 per cent from June. 1945. husiness research of Ohio State university revealed today.

Building activity figures, based on the value of contracts awarded, showed that residential construction increased 37 per cent during June and public works construction was upped 182 per cent.

Employment and pay rolls in manufacturing industries were up one per cent and two per cent respectively in May from April but were down 18 per cent and 25 per cent from May, 1945, the bureau
