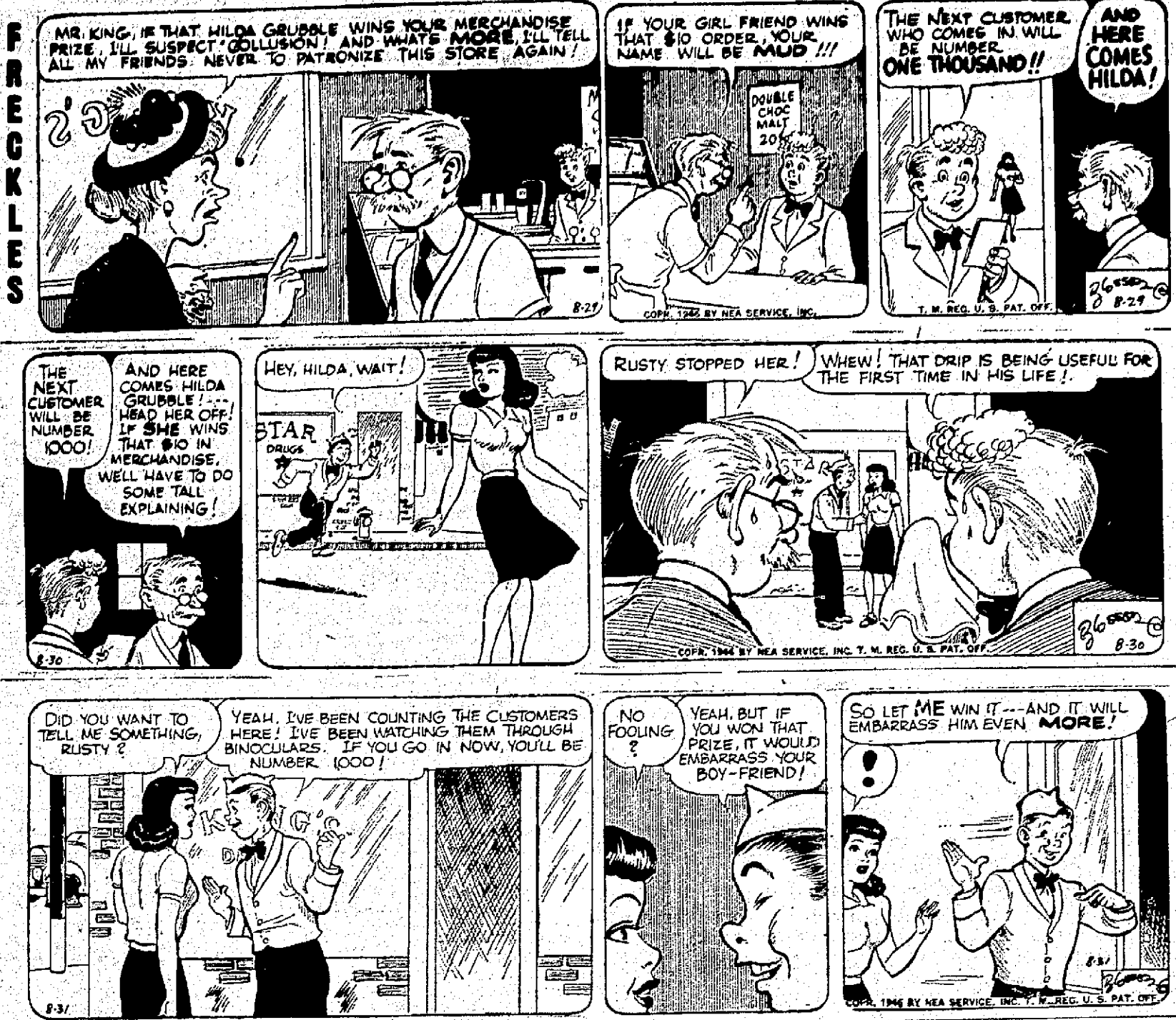


Mystery, Comedy, History-- All in Films Here Saturday

CLEVELAND, Aug. 31—(AP)—A "dead band" in which jet engines fail to operate was disclosed today by officials of the aircraft engine research laboratory of the National Advisory Committee for Aeronautics. The "dead band" is a combination of circumstances rather than a particular area in the atmosphere, although altitude has much to do with it.

Cool Weather May Slash Total U.S. Corn Crop, Experts Say

WASHINGTON, Aug. 31—(UP)—The weather bureau indicated today that the cool, dry weather that has prevailed over much of the corn belt the last few days may result in a further reduction in the corn crop. The agriculture department, as a result of unfavorable growing weather the first half of August, already has revised its estimate of the corn crop downward some 55,000,000 bushels. It still expects a record crop, however.

New Device Slows 'Chutes. WASHINGTON, Aug. 31—(UP)—The Army Air Forces today unveiled the "sand bullet" a new device designed to eliminate landing hazards for parachuting troops or supplies. It consists of a U-shaped tube with an explosive charge in the center and a charge of sand in each end. A weighted wire which touches the ground before the parachuting object sets off the charge and the recoil of the explosion slows the downward progress of the chute.

When the dawn of 1946's first September morn breaks over Sunday's skies, the new radio program season will start in earnest. As far as a current compilation goes, a total of 58 shows will have found places on the network schedules before winter. The overall total is expected to be 65 or more. The majority are coming back from vacations of varying periods, but the number also includes 30 new programs. Among these are the Mel Blanc series for CBS, Don Ameche for NBC, the Gold and Silver Minstrels on MBS, and Henry Morgan Stanza of ABC. The September parade opens with Sunday's return of Edgar Bergen and Charlie McCarthy to NBC and Ozzie and Harriet Nelson to CBS. Vacation traveling isn't the real it's supposed to be, according to Judy Canova, who will return to the airwaves on the "Judy Canova Show" over NBC at 9 p. m. Saturday. Lois Gentile, young mezzo-soprano, and Bruce Foote, baritone, will be soloists on "Chicago Theatre of the Air" over MBS at 9 p. m. Highlights of the program will be a medley of selections from Bizet's "Carmen."
