## Truck Drivers Postpone Vote

NEW YORK, Sept. 6 — (INS) — Striking truck drivers who are tightening a clamp on New York City's industrial arteries closed the door today on an early resumption of negotiations with employers.

Local 807 of the AFL Teamsters and Chauffeurs Union, which had arranged a meeting for this afternoon to vote on Mayor William O'Dwyer's compromise wage formula, voted to postpone the meeting until next Sunday.

The strike, meanwhile, was extended by 10,000 drivers in Northern New Jersey who quit their jobs in sympathy with their 15,000 fellow unionists in New York.

Deliveries of canned goods and groceries from major terminals were at a standstill. The two largest biscuit companies in the metropolitan area halted all distribution and the milk supply faced sharp curtailment.

## Martial Display Plan Called Off

ATHENS, Sept. 6 — (AP) — Plans to parade American airplanes across the skies of Athens were called off today as the U. S. aircraft carrier Franklin D. Roosevelt and escorting vessels reached Greece.

Rear Adm. John H. Cassidy, commander of the task force, announced at Naples last Saturday that the Roosevelt would send up 120 planes to write FDR above Athens—"at the request of the Greek government."

A naval attache of the U. S. embassy, said today the air show had been called off because it could not be integrated into a jammed four-day program.

Informants who arrived with the carrier said the call-off order came from a diplomatic source in Athens.

WESTINGHOUSE STOCK ISSUE OVERSUBSCRIBED

NEW YORK, Sept. 6 — (AP) — Kulin, Loeb & Co. today announced that an offering of \$30,000,000 of Westinghouse Electric Corp. new 2 1/2-8 per cent debentures maturing Sept. 1, 1971, has been oversubscribed and the books closed.

The debentures now are quoted at 100 3/4 bid and 101 1/4 asked—up from this morning's initial offering price of 100 1/2.

The banking firm announced yesterday while the stock market was retreating that it would go ahead with the offering.
