Ohio Sales Tax Adds 2 Million

COLUMBUS, Sept. 13—(INS)—A two-million-dollar week during the period ended Aug. 31 raised state sales tax collections for the year to \$38,173,580, 17 million higher than for the first eight months of 1945.

State Treasurer Don H. Ebricht's weekly report today showed receipts of \$2,094,901 that week, compared with \$1,360,633 for the week ended Sept. 1, 1945.

FIRE DESTROYS MAIL

CINCINNATI, Sept. 13—(AP)—Half of a mail car cargo of letters and packages on the Pennsylvania railroad's Pittsburgh-Cincinnati train, No. 213, was destroyed by fire last night. Norwood Fire Chief Thomas Fisher said. An investigation is under way. Fisher said, to find the cause of the fire which was burning when the train arrived at the suburban Norwood station. Sixty-seven passengers were removed from other coaches of the train and bussed to the union terminal before firemen brought the blaze under control.
