



WASHINGTON, Sept. 17-(AP)-The nation's courts ground out nearly one-third as many divorces as there were marriages in 1945, setting divorce record 25.5 per cent over that of 1944, the previous peak year.


In reporting the divorce-marriage ratio, the Federal Security agency said more than 502,000 marriages ended in divorce courts last year, while 1,618,331 couples formed new families. The marriage rate was 8.8 per cent below the peak year of 1942.
