\$800 IN BONDS ARE RECOVERED

Loot of Lima Auto Robbery Found Near Wapak

Twenty-three government bonds

worth \$800, a large amount of personal papers and three safe drawers were turned over to Lima police Wednesday for return to the Lima Cadillac Sales and Service Co. West and Spring-sts, after being identified as contents of a safe stolen there the night of Aug. 21.

Sheriff William Lietzer of Auglaize-co, who called local police

Tuesday night, reported the safe contents were discovered by Don Metzger, farmer, of Wapakoneta Route 4, about a mile north of Wapakoneta near the Baltimore and Ohio railroad tracks.

No trace of the safe was found in the vicinity where the bonds and papers were recovered. The

bonds included 16 for \$25, six for \$50 and one for \$100. The safe was taken from the Cadillac agency after an unsuccessful attempt had been made to open it there. The original report to local police did not make any estimate of total value of contents of the safe.
