# SUCCESS MARKS HARDIN-CO FAIR

Exposition at Kenton Is Completed on Friday

KENTON, Sept. 28.—Hardin-co's annual fair ended Friday afternoon with the total attendance reaching 30,000, fair officials announced. The large crowd of school children Friday boosted the attendance past 10,000. Total receipts have not been reported. President Bert Frederick and other officials expressed satisfaction that this was Hardin-co's biggest fair since it re-opened seven years ago. He added that the fair attracted the finest program in racing and a large agricultural exhibit. Hardin-co Agricultural Agent B. C. Bradford reported that from the FFA and 4-H auction of steers Friday, the average sale price was \$418 a head while total receipts for 41 steers was \$17,137.01. Dale Lotz, north of Kenton, sold the grand champion steer to Morris Sturges, Kenton custom butcher, for 52 cents per pound. Top price for hogs was 31 cents and top price for lambs was 30 cents. James Kreglow, Ada, sold the champion hog and Newton Ramsey of Ridgeway the champion sheep. In the district Jersey show which was held at the Hardin-co fair for the first time this year, Newell Davids and Sons won the ribbon for the champion bull, Meritt Wilson, the champion heifer calf, Charles Walt farms, junior champion heifer calf and Ann Daniels, champion 4-H heifer calf.
