

Order Hints Kai-Shek Has Abandoned Peace Hopes

NANKING, Oct. 11 -- (UP) -Nationalist China was placed on an official war footing today by a government mandate affecting some 300,000,000 people which restored military control over all Nationalist civilian administra-

All males between the ages of 18 and 45 were made eligible for military conscription under the mandate. Some observers interpreted the order as a virtual abandonment of peace hopes by Chiang Kai-Shek's Kuomintang government.




