

A-Under the present law as altered by a recent amendment, you can name any person you wish as either primary or con-Cooper, general manager of the tingent beneficiary. If your mother dies, and then you die, before miere performance to new songs, you get a chance to change your beneficiary, the insurance will go AF chief, on the "Highways in into your estate, and your brother will get his share of it when your estate is probated. If your mother should receive your insurance and girl from Hubert Updike III and your brother is still alive when she dies, your mother's will will determine whether or not your brother will eventually receive part of your insurance. The only way you can make sure that your brother doesn't get a share of your insurance, regardless of what happens—and that is apparently what you are worried about-is to make your mother primary beneficiary and to name another per-

son as contingent beneficiary. Q-1 named my mother beneficiary in my government insurservice. Since then she has died. assume that my father will be the beneficiary now. Is this true? A-No. If there is no beneficiary named in your policy now, the proceeds in the event of your death will be placed in your etsate. And your estate will be divided by the court, which is sometimes a costly and time-consuming business.




