"If there is one thing the Nuernberg condemnations show," the Journal said, "it is that no nation will dare allow itself to become weak and therefore open to defeat."

The editorial said conquest would mean that the victor would hold the loser guilty of aggression and conduct a purge based upon the Nuernberg precedent.
