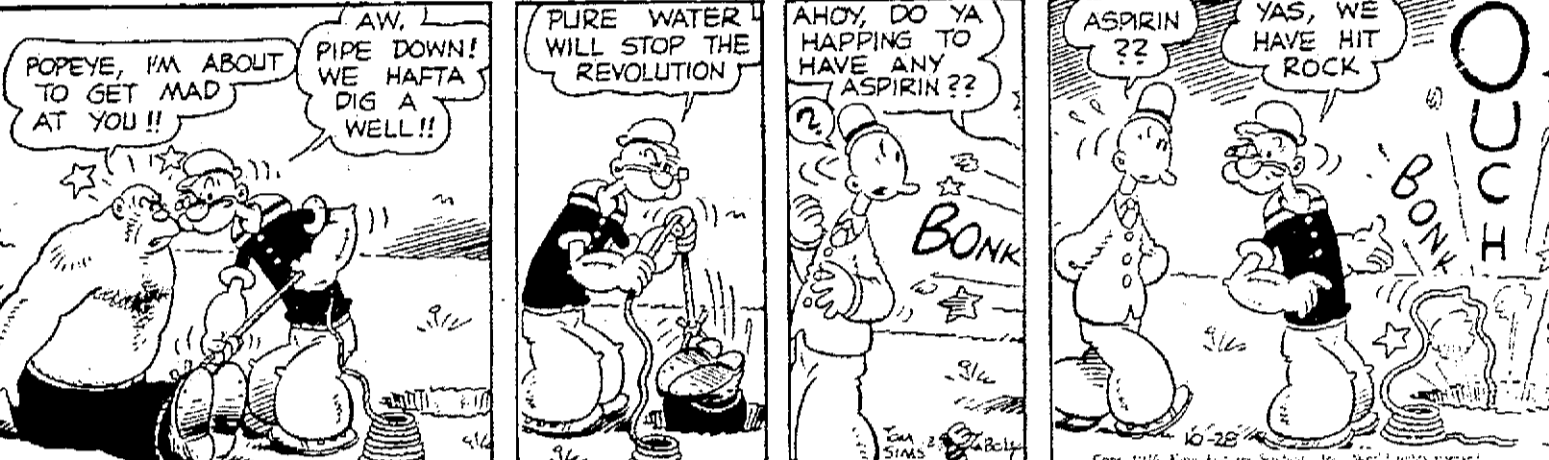

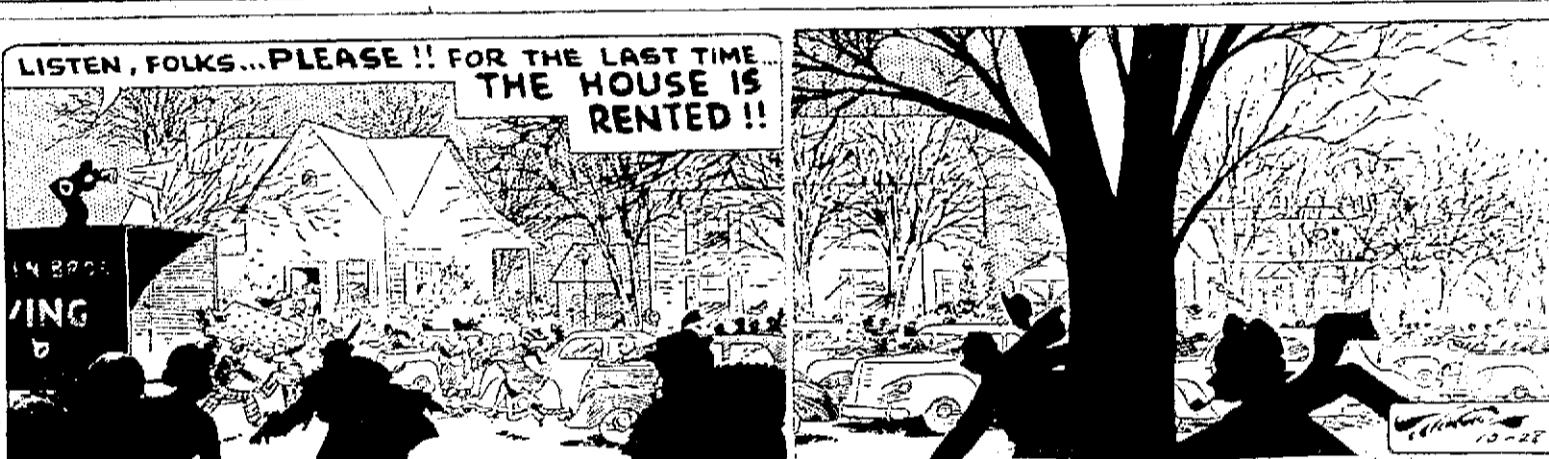

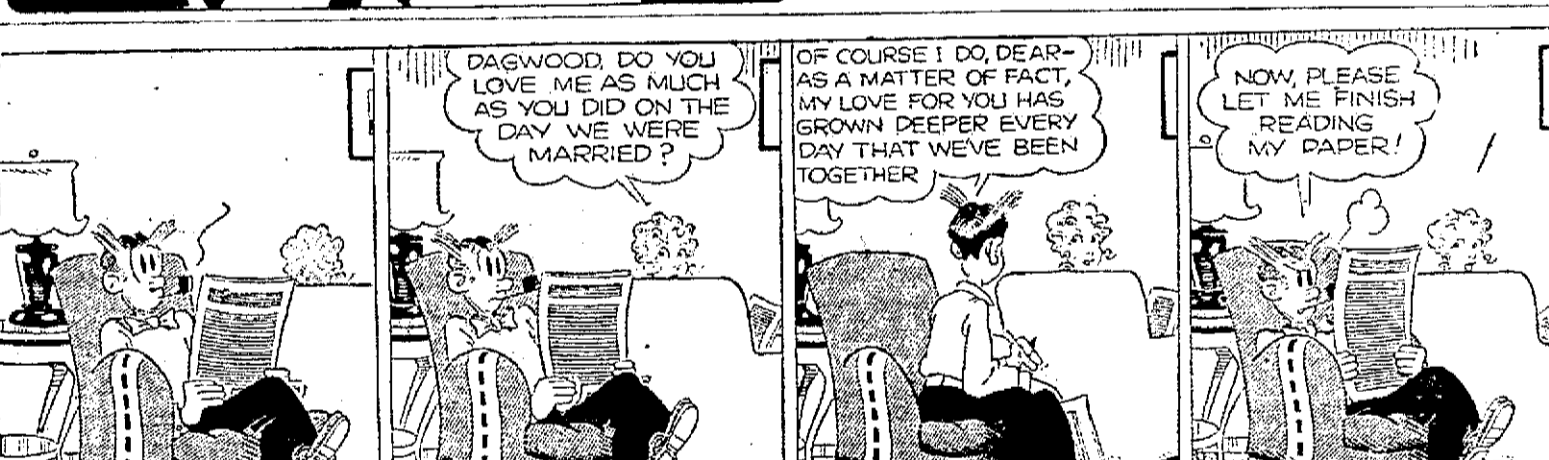

DETROIT, Oct. 28.—(INS)—Admiral Raymond Kelly Turner, the "Terrible" Turner who led Allied amphibious forces to a share of glory in the Pacific victory,

declared tonight that America must preserve its military might while traveling the road to peace.

Turner told a Navy Day crowd from the steps of Detroit's city hall that "a solid, intelligent and courageous American front" must be evinced in the United States search for a lasting peace.

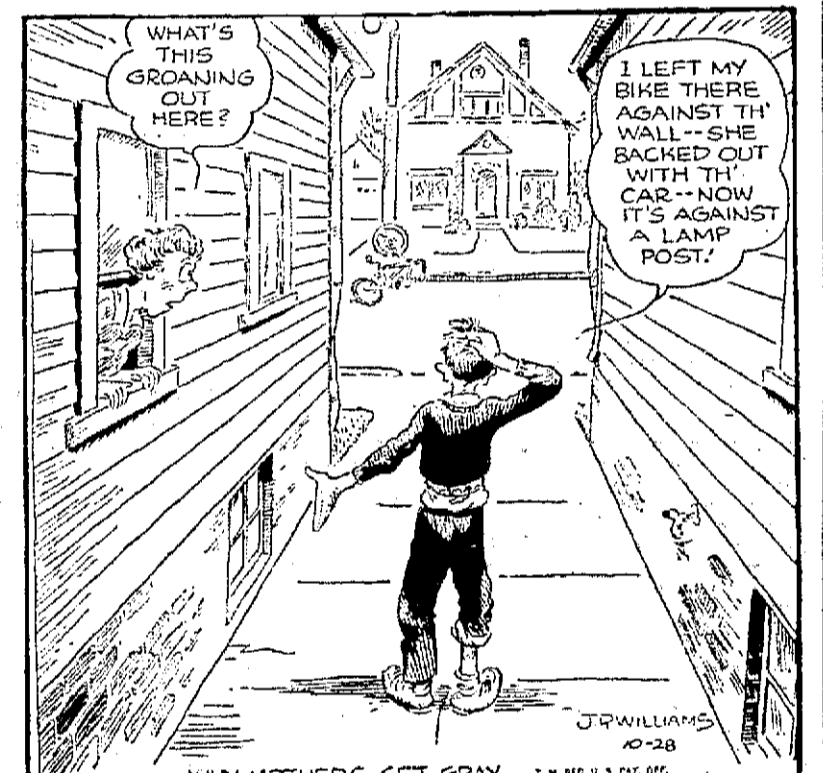
