Delphos May Get Industry

DELPHOS, Nov. 4—Efforts to bring a large manufacturing concern here were being continued Saturday by a special group of financial men after an investigation of a location was sought by a representative of a southern manufacturer who plans to open a branch in Ohio.

Business men declined to name the industry which has considered Delphos a possible site. A decision in the matter may be reached within two weeks if present plans of the concern and local interests are carried out, according to one Delphos spokesman.

The proposed plant would require over 40 acres on which the plant would be built at a cost of over one and a quarter million dollars. The concern is said to have asked donation of the site and financial support in the project. The plant would hire approximately 1,500 people, it was reported.

Refugees Shout Abuse on British

FAMAGUSTA, Cyprus, Nov. 4—(INS)—Jewish refugee women spat at British troops and shouted abuse today when 1,279 illegal immigrants transferred from Haifa were put ashore for detention on Cyprus Island.

Jewish women carrying a stretcher case at first refused to hand it over to the soldiers. Large numbers of immigrants showed signs of having been subjected to tear gas—either in their previous fight with the Spanish crew aboard the intercepted blockade runner San Dimitrio, or with the British at Haifa.
