

# Warner's 'Juvenile Shows' Have Lima Try-Out Saturday

Lima's younger generation will be on the receiving end of Warner Brothers' newly formed "Juvenile Joy Shows," the first of which will be presented at 10 a. m. Saturday at the Sigma theatre, according to Ted Davidson, manager of the local movie house.

Eric Johnston, president of the Motion Picture Association of America, has visited the major studios of Hollywood and has received their whole-hearted consent to stock a film library with pictures that had particular appeal to youngsters.

Davidson reported that cooperation is the biggest thing and will have to be had from youngsters as well as parents in order that these shows may be a success and may continue as a regular Saturday morning offering.

Reports of Saturday's program have been forwarded to elementary schools of Lima, he related, including the fact that the Children's Film Library now is very much on trial, and that the parents and school faculties have been given what they have demanded from the movie industry for many years.

An example of non-cooperation was presented recently by Omar Ranney of The Cleveland Press when he pointed out that in Lakewood, where there has been a similar tie-up between PTA units, schools and theatres since last fall, the cooperative plan met with success at first, but since, parental cooperation has fallen off.

The first movie to be offered in Lima at the Sigma will be "Five Little Peppers in Trouble" and will be followed by "The Under-pup" Saturday, Nov. 16; "Sandy Gets Her Man," Nov. 23; "Mid-summer Night's Dream," Nov. 30. Other films will be booked in later, it was reported.

Davidson also pointed out that, as an inducement to the younger patrons, these films have been recorded on 9-30 a. m. in order to allow the youngsters to become comfortably located before the feature begins.

"Deception" is the current feature at the Ohio and stars Bette Davis, Paul Henreid and Claude Rains. The Quilna is offering "The Walls Came Tumbling Down" with Lee Bowman and Marguerite Chapman, also "Blondie Knows Best." State fans will get a treat Sunday when "OSS" with Alan Ladd comes to the theatre with "Inside Job" as the co-feature. "Gentleman Misbehaves" and "Sundown Valley" are scheduled for opening at the Lyric Saturday midnight while "Typhoon" and "Ghost Breakers" are due to open at the Allen Sunday. Also opening Sunday will be "Ablene Town" and "Boston Blackie Booked on Suspicion" at the Gloria Drive-In.
