Cambridge Recount Fails To Pass Vote

CAMBRIDGE, Nov. 20.—(UP)—The proposed one-mill levy to increase salaries of Cambridge municipal employees was still unpassed today after a recount of the city's 23 precincts.

City employees posted \$5 for each precinct for a recount after the levy failed to pass in the last general election. Twenty votes were picked up to make the deficiency only 43 as against 63 previously.

Typhoon Claims 518 Casualties

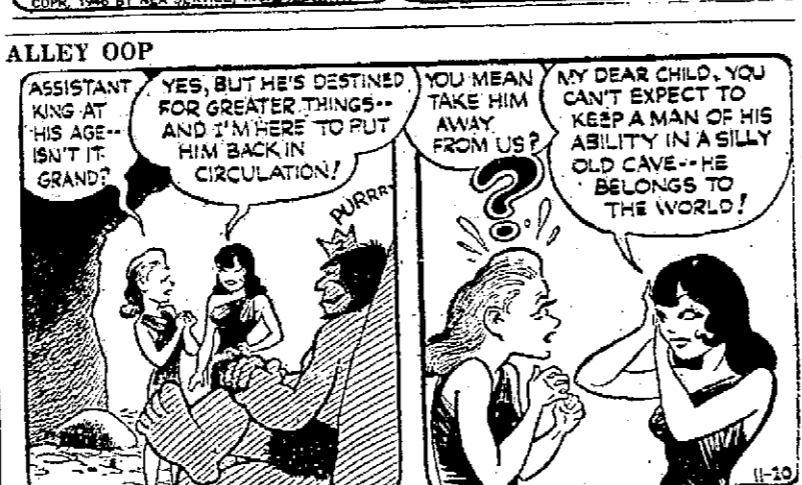
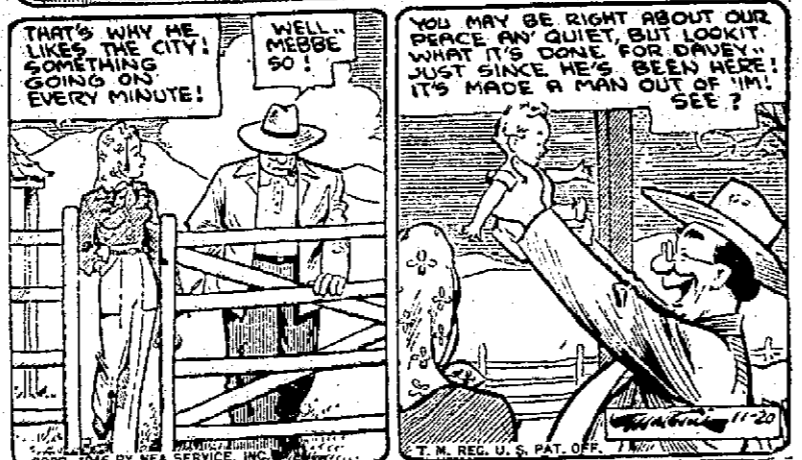
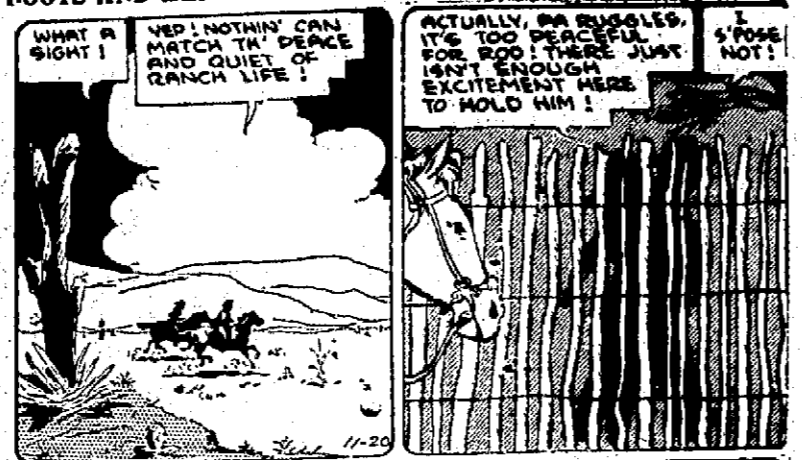
