

# 'They Were Sisters' Opens At Sigma on Wednesday

Based on the popular novel by Dorothy Whipple, the new film release, "They Were Sisters," comes to the Sigma theatre Wednesday. The dramatic picture tells the story of three sisters, their lives, loves and misfortunes.

Heading the large cast are Phyllis Calvert and James Mason, outstanding British stars. Miss Calvert is seen as the calm and gentle Lucy, who thru her love and devotion for her younger sisters, tries to salvage their unhappy marriages. Ann Crawford, another English actress, enacts the bright and brittle sister Vera, who makes an unfortunate marriage and then becomes involved in a scandal. Charlotte, played by still another English actress, is a sympathetic person but lacks the courage and character of her older sister, Lucy.





### CONVICTED IN SUGAR CASE

CLEVELAND, Dec. 10.—(AP)—Arthur Keresty, 30, Pittsburgh, was convicted in Judge Emerich B. Freed's federal court yesterday of obtaining 163,000 pounds of sugar with 32,600 counterfeit ration stamps. Government attorneys said Keresty was on probation from a five-year sentence for draft-dodging. Paul Jerome Wald and William J. Barnes of Youngstown pleaded guilty Tuesday to aiding Keresty in securing and disposing of the sugar. Wald was fined \$750 and Barnes \$500.
