You will note that the number of Diesel and electric locomotives combined was 3.730, not 11,598 as shown in The News article. It is possible that 31.932 is the correct number of coal-burning steam locomotives, but the total number of steam locomotives was 53,683. The general impression from the article would be that about 27% of the locomotives in service are Diesels and electric, while the correct percentage, you will observe, is 7% for Diesels and 1.8% for electric. The article also shows that

there were only 65 steam locomotives on order on Oct. 1. The Steam number reported by the Locomotive Research Institute, Inc., was 546; this, of course, includes those for foreign shipment as well as for domestic railroads, but to show that there were only 65 steam locomotives on order surely is misleading. The number of Diesel and electric locomotives on order, as shown in your article, appears to be correct. Yours very truly. L. A. LARSEN.
