Churchill Puts Mandate on Spot

Says Palestine U. S. Worry, Too, or UN's
LONDON (U.P.)— Winston Churchill demanded in Commons today that Britain surrender the Palestine mandate to the United Nations unless the United States agreed to share equally in responsibility for the Holy Land.

Says Government Cowed
He charged that the government had been cowed by the Jewish underground in Palestine, and admonished the cabinet to "at least beat yourselves like men."

Churchill spoke of the kidnapping of two Britons by the Jewish underground in Palestine this week and the granting of a stay of execution to Dov Gruner, for whose life they were held hostage.

'Good gracious me,' he cried, "how should we have got through the late struggle—the war—if we had allowed ourselves to be cowed in this way? This is the road of abject failure."

British Families to Leave Palestine
JERUSALEM—British women and children will be evacuated by Feb. 4 "so military operations in Palestine will not be hampered," it was announced officially today.
