### Information for Veterans

Q. I was in the army for 10 years, from 1925 to 1935. Am I entitled to treatment in a veterans hospital? I had an honorable discharge.  
A. Since you are a peacetime veteran, you are entitled to such hospitalization only if you have a service-connected disability.  
Q. A year ago I converted my NSLI from a term to an ordinary life policy, but have never received a regular insurance policy similar to the one issued to my father for his World War I policy. Will these be issued?  
A. Yes. At the present time policies are being prepared by the VA but as yet are not ready for distribution. Persons holding NSLI are being issued certificates pending the issue of these policies.  
Q. I am not a veteran, but desire to enroll in the ROTC while attending college. Are non-veterans being accepted?  
A. Yes. Any person successfully completing an ROTC course is given a commission in the Organized Reserve Corps.  
Q. Upon discharge I signed a statement that I was in "good health" and did not desire to file a disability claim. Can I now file a claim for a condition which I believe is due to the service?  
A. Yes, you can file a claim for service-incurred disabilities any time after your discharge. Section 105 of the G. I. bill provides: "No person in the armed forces shall be required to sign a statement of any nature relating to the origin, incurrence, or aggravation of any disease or injury he may have, and any such statement against his own interest signed at any time shall be null and void and of no force and effect."  
Q. If the draft law is resumed during the coming month, will fathers be called for induction into the army if they are non-veterans and between the ages of 19 and 30 years?  
A. No. The recent draft extension law specifically prohibits the induction of bona fide fathers.
