Senate Passes Tavern 'Check' License Revocation

A bill giving state beverage tax agents authority to go into circuit courts and seek revocation of tavern licenses was passed by the Wisconsin senate today by a vote of 23-10.

The measure, which now goes to the assembly for action, is a compromise to a bill that originally provided that tavern operators, before they could be granted licenses by local licensing committees, had to have a state "basic permit."

The compromise does not require the basic permit, but does allow state agents to go in and revoke licenses of improperly-run taverns that manage to obtain licenses from their local authorities.

State agents can seek a circuit court revocation of tavern licenses on any of these grounds:

ONE. That the tavern is "disorderly, riotous, indecent, or an improper establishment."

TWO. That sales have been made to minors.

THREE. That sales have been made to habitual drunkards or to customers who already are intoxicated.

FOUR. That the tavernkeeper failed to comply with the sanitary requirements laid down by the board of health.

FIVE. That criminals or prostitutes were allowed to loiter on the premises.

SIX. That the tavernkeeper at any time violated any federal or state law or been convicted of any felony or any offense against the laws relating to the sale of beer and liquor.

SEVEN. That the tavern operator does not possess the "legal qualifications" for a license.

Under the new law, the board of health, county board of supervisors, or city board of health may issue a "basic permit" to a tavern operator if the operator meets the following requirements:

ONE. The operator must be at least 21 years of age.

TWO. The operator must be a resident of the county in which the tavern is located.

THREE. The operator must be a citizen of the United States.

FOUR. The operator must be of good moral character.

FIVE. The operator must be of good financial standing.

SIX. The operator must be of good reputation in the community.

SEVEN. The operator must be of good character in the community.

EIGHT. The operator must be of good character in the community.

NINE. The operator must be of good character in the community.

TEN. The operator must be of good character in the community.

NEW LAWS OF WISCONSIN
