Scientists Unite in Campaign to Fight 'Sleeping Sickness'

(Central Press Dispatch) BAKERSFIELD, Calif.—Scientific strategists in the war on encephalitis, the so-called "sleeping sickness," have renewed their annual assault on the disease

diagnosis of the disease, and assisted in developing serum diagnostic tests.

Fourth—First isolated western equine and St. Louis encephalitis viruses from naturally infected mosquitoes, notably Culex tarsalis, the common house mosquito.

Spearheaded by a group of pioneer scientists of the Hooper foundation at the University of California medical center, the scientific effort this year will be the largest and most comprehensive ever undertaken in the battle against encephalitis.

A group of University of California scientists are now here operating a field laboratory in cooperation with the California state department of public health and the Kern county health department and hospital, to study the disease on the ground during its season which ends in September.

Evidence Accumulating: Annually the disease strikes up to 1,000 victims in the hot valleys of California, notably the Kern, Joaquin and Sacramento, and evidence is accumulating that many cases of poliomyelitis in widely scattered parts of the country are actually encephalitis.

The effort this year is being coordinated with studies conducted under the direction of the same group of scientists in a laboratory set up by the University of California scientists in Tokyo last year to study and guard American troops against the dread Japanese "B" encephalitis.
