Baseball Player Sues Officials NEW YORK (UP) - Danny Gardella, formerly an outfielder with the New York Giants and last year a player in the Mexican League, has filed a \$300,000 lawsuit against top-ranking baseball officials in federal court, it was learned today. Gardella, who says that he has been suspended from organized baseball for five years, is bringing suit under the Sherman and Clayton anti-trust laws, claiming that the major-league player contract, and particularly its "reserve clause," is monopolistic and in restraint of trade. Because of the suspension, Gardella claims that he has been deprived of his livelihood, had his ability as a player destroyed, and suffered damages to the extent of \$100,000. He claims that the laws, he could collect three times that sum if his suit is successful.
