Palestine Protest Meeting Set for Tonight at Bassick

Spearheaded by the Bridgeport Labor Committee on Palestine with the support of civic and church groups, a huge rally protesting British policy in the Holy Land and condemning treatment of Jewish refugees will take place at 8 o'clock tonight in the Bassick High school auditorium. The rally, open to all, will be addressed by Gov. James L. McConeghy, Thomas J. Dodd, former prosecutor at the Nuremberg trials, Joseph Schlossberg, national chairman of the American Trade Union Council for Palestine, and Al Camp, creator of the "L'I Abner" cartoon. The Labor committee has drafted a resolution for the approval of the rally calling for the endorsement of the United States' stand on the majority report of the United Nations special committee on Palestine, asking the immediate admission of 150,000 Jewish displaced persons into Palestine, and condemning British brutality of Jewish refugees. Leigh Danenberg who has just returned from a six week's tour of Europe, and Mayor McLevy will speak briefly at the rally. The principal addresses will be broadcast over WICC from 9:15 to 10 p. m. Guests on the speakers platform will include Lt. Gov. James C. Shannon, James J. O'Connell, chairman of the Bridgeport Chapter of the American Christian Committee on Palestine, Timothy M.

GROUP WILL PRESS CHURCH-STATE ISSUE

WASHINGTON, Oct. 13 - (AP) Sixty Protestant leaders from all sections of the country, headed by Bishop G. Bromley Oxnam of New York, voted today to create a nationwide organization to "insure the separation of church and state." Dr. J. M. Dawson, secretary of the group, said the organization's constitution and platform will be presented at a conference to be held in St. Louis in the near future. He said the need for such an organization, embracing all faiths, arises from what he described as "efforts to get public money for sectarian purposes, such as free text books for parochial schools." Dr. Dawson told a reporter that several bills are now before Congress and before state legislatures seeking to use public funds for sectarian purposes. "We are interested only in resisting any encroachment on the American doctrine for separation of church and state, which we believe involves religious liberty," he said.

POLAND SETS ITS HOPES ON BALANCED BUDGET

WARSAW - (AP) The Polish government's income the first half of 1947 exceeded by \$65,000,000 its expenditures and the nation's financial picture is sound, says Konstanty Dabrowski, minister of finance. Dabrowski said failure thus far of the International Bank for Economic construction to set upon Poland's request for a \$600,000,000 loan had adversely affected investments based on foreign credits but government-financed investments had not suffered. Poland expects not only to have a balanced budget at the end of 1947 but a surplus of around 11,000,000,000 zlotys (\$110,000,000).
