Q. What is the story connected with the small cemetery within Lockbourne Army Air Base at Columbus, Ohio? L. A. B.

A. This is the final resting place of Claudius P. Aubert, the personal drummer-boy of Napoleon. He is credited with drumming Napoleon into Russia and accompanied him on the return journey. In the 1850's Aubert emigrated to the United States and settled in Ohio.

Q. When were the Riley Whiting clocks made in Connecticut? C. D. W.

A. Riley Whiting of Winsted went into partnership with his brothers-in-law, Samuel and Luther Hoadley in 1809 and became sole owner of the clock business in 1812. He made large numbers of wood clocks and some eight-day brass clocks. He died in 1835 at Jacksonville, Illinois, while on a business trip.

Q. Will green wood cut late in the fall be seasoned enough for use as firewood this winter? R. R.

A. Green wood cut in the late fall months or winter will not burn satisfactorily and it will not improve during the winter, unless it is piled in a warm, dry place, and then considerable time will be required to season it.

Q. Have sea battles any effect upon fish? D. B. T.

A. The firing of big guns does not kill fish, but explosions in the water do. Though some fishermen believe that fish are frightened away by gunfire, this has not been proved. Sound in air is transmitted to water only slightly.

Q. Does it hurt an ostrich to cut its feathers? A. B.

A. Scientists say that it does not hurt an ostrich to cut its feathers if the feathers are ripe, that is, full grown. If the stump or quill is not pulled out after cutting, it will be pushed out by the new feather which starts to grow beneath it.

It is a strategic procedure in rubber bridge to try to keep the opponents from getting into a game contract. In today's hand everything was normal until North made the optimistic bid of four diamonds.

Most tournament players holding the East hand would have bid four spades, remembering that West had opened the bidding with a heart and had supported spades.

But this East player realized that if he bid four spades, the opponents probably would bid five diamonds as a sacrifice, and he was afraid that they might make the contract.

As a matter of fact, they did make five diamonds, because West was not on the job.

Dummy won the opening spade lead and the queen of clubs was led. Declarer led the ace and East won with the king. Now East laid down the queen of hearts, and West very cleverly gave him an encouraging heart, the eight-spot. But of course East had no more hearts to lead. He came back with a club, hoping against hope that his partner could ruff it.

But North won with the ace, ruffed a spade in dummy, picked up the trumps, and discarded two hearts on the good clubs. Thus he confined his losses to a club and a heart.

West should have realized that his partner did not have very many hearts. He should have overtaken the queen of hearts with the king in order to cash the ace and make sure of defeating the contract with a second heart trick plus a heart ruff.
