Q. What is the oldest incorporated company in the world? T. B. O. A. The distinction is claimed for the Copper Mining Company of Sweden. Its charter dates back to 1347.

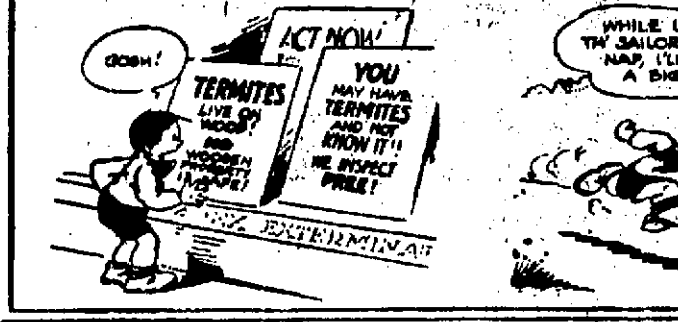
'Pressive' Progressives

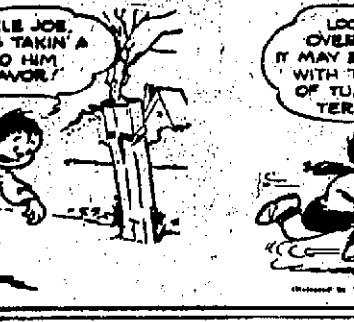
LABOR'S STAKE
