DO YOU ENJOY double dummy bridge problems? A double dummy problem is a hand in which the contract must be made against any possible defense. Many players find them interesting and can recognize one quickly.
Norman Perlestein of Los Angeles, Calif., sent me the one shown today, a 13-card problem I had never seen before. I have not shown any bidding, as bidding is not given in double dummy problems. You are simply told that the final contract is seven spades by South. West opens the queen of clubs, and you are to make seven against any defense. The best thing to do is to lay the cards out and go to work on the problem. Here is the solution.

Again declarer leads the suit discarded by East, wins with dummy's ace, and as East has only the blank king left, the five is led. The king falls and declarer trumps it.
