Sturgeon Bay's Valuation Up 60%

STURGEON BAY.—(U.P.)—City officials today completed a revaluation program that boosted the city's assessed valuation to \$9,376,855, about 20 per cent larger than the 1946 figure of \$5,827,845.

Officials hoped the revaluation would drop the tax rate from \$39 per \$1,000 to \$30, but an impending 1948 budget of about \$350,000 was expected to make the new rate \$37.

Without the reassessment program, the rate would have soared to about \$54, or \$11 more than the state officials said.

'State of Union' Good Despite Weaknesses

No matter what you do to it, "State of the Union" is still a fine play.

Just the same, some things you shouldn't do.

In its current version, now on the Parkway stage, the 1946 Pulitzer Prize play is over-acted in some spots, under-acted in others, and lashed to such a break-neck pace that parts of the dialogue are thrown away as waste.

Nevertheless, it's good entertainment. Occasionally the cast relaxes to catch its breath and lets you see the characters as real people. Now and then they all get together on their timing. And they are at their best in the moments of the clear-cut structure, the logic, and sheer intelligence of the Howard Lindsay-Russell Crouse drama bring it all back into focus.

This year, Kay Francis is playing the role of Mary Matthews, whose husband gets a chance at the Republican nomination for president. She makes a stunning looking heroine, but she insists on portraying her as a Great Lady, holding up a perfect hand for silence during her big lines.

The candidate, K. Elmo Lowe seemed to be too busy trying to read his lines as fast as Walter Winchell to get much acting in. And Matthews needs some sympathetic understanding if he's to look more like Wendell Willkie and less like a stuffed shirt. Actors in the secondary roles—Forrest Henderson as the candidate's mistress, Eleanor Wilson, as the candidate's mistress, and Ben Lackland, as the reporter who files his principles for the duration of the campaign—all are well cast and convincing.

The authors keep busy reaching their work to keep it excitingly contemporaneous. There is a reference to Wallace here and there, and an allusion to his recent announcement of his candidacy—"I didn't figure Taft was serious," the veteran politician retorts glumly, "You can always figure Taft as serious."

But there is more to "State of the Union" than wit and freshness. In spite of alterations, weak casting, and a noticeable case of on-the-road script, it still is ringing with its original message.

Parents Don't Get Child's Viewpoint, Rothney Tells PTA

The parent of today fails to understand the point of view of his child, Prof. John W. M. Rothney, assistant professor of education at the University of Wisconsin, told the East high school Parent-Teachers assn. Monday night.

"We need to study our children more scientifically," Prof. Rothney declared. "The greatest weakness of parents today is that they don't try to understand the strength or weakness of their own children's point of view. And each generation of parents thinks it is the 'modern' parent."

Don't force the child to come up to an average, the speaker warned. There is no "average" child, and each inherits the strong and weak points of his parents. No two children have the same environment or heredity, he added.

Prof. Rothney urged the need of gathering information about the child from such sources as his pals and his teacher. Only with fuller knowledge of his child can the parent help plan his future or solve his problems, he said.

Prof. Rothney's talk was part of the program for "Go-to-School" night, which launched activities in observance of American Education week.

Oil Firm Worker Jailed for Thefts

Jay S. Dunham, a transient employe of the Black Eng'g Oil Co. here, was sentenced to four months in Superior Jail late Monday by Superior Judge Roy H. Proctor for stealing \$222 from the firm's cash register.

Dunham came to Madison about a month ago after serving 58 days in a Kentucky jail for rifling a car there. He was hired at the oil company on Oct. 16, and two days later began taking money from the till. His thefts continued until Oct. 30, when he was arrested, pleaded guilty to the charge, and was sent to jail to await sentence. Judge Proctor ordered his sentence to begin as of Nov. 1.

The judge also ordered that \$84.50, which Dunham had in his possession upon arrest, be turned over to the oil firm.
