SENATOR SOAPER SAYS:

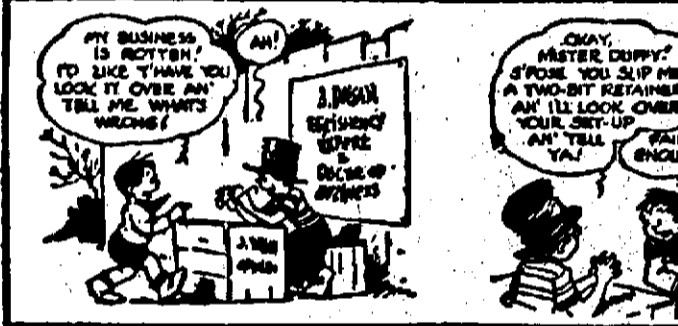
STRANGE that no Russian ever has received the Nobel Peace prize, while 10 of these coveted awards have gone to American amitymongers.

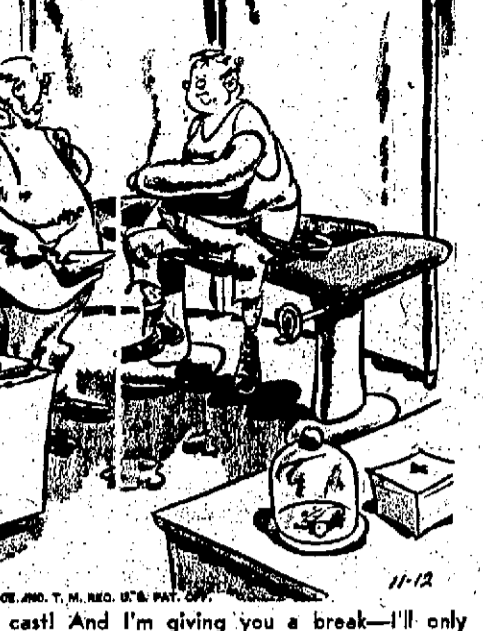
