Since 1924, all minor parties combined have polled from 1/4 to 2/5 per cent of the total popular vote. Q. How many buildings were torn down to make room for Rockefeller Center in New York City? P. R. V. A. Two hundred and twenty-nine small structures were razed to clear the 12 acres occupied by this group of buildings. Q. What is the normal temperature of a cold-blooded animal? E. F. A. Cold-blooded animals, such as fish and reptiles, take on the temperature of their surroundings. Unlike warm-blooded animals, they have no means of regulating their own body temperature. Q. What is a visa? J. E. A. A visa is an indorsement made on a passport by the proper authorities, showing that the passport has been examined and that the bearer may be permitted to proceed to the country by whose representatives the indorsement was made.


