Two groups of girls practiced typewriting three minutes daily for 36 days, one group working for speed, the other for accuracy. They were then about even. They skipped four months without practice. Then the speed group wrote 383 words in 10 minutes with 22 errors per 100 words; the accuracy group, 450 words with 1.2 errors. Recent experiments indicate, however, that for best results you should start by working for moderate accuracy and moderate speed.
