ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS

By HASKINS. A reader has asked the answer to any question... Q. How were the ships built on the Great Lakes during the war transported to the sea? S. O. M. A. After changes had been made in bridges in the Chicago area, commercial vessels up to 321 feet in length and submarines of 307 feet length, assembled on the Great Lakes, reached the sea via the Chicago Drainage Canal and the Illinois and Mississippi Rivers.

Q. What is the advantage of corrugating iron? S. E. L. A. Flat sheet metal tends to buckle and get out of shape with every change of temperature. The corrugations increase the stiffness of the metal and adapt it to numerous purposes for which it would otherwise be less suitable.

Q. Why do Hindus bathe in the Ganges? V. E. B. A. The Ganges is the sacred river of India. The Hindus believe that if they bathe in it their sins will be washed away, and that if their ashes are cast into it the soul will go to paradise.
