Q. What is the longest swim on record? L. P. S.

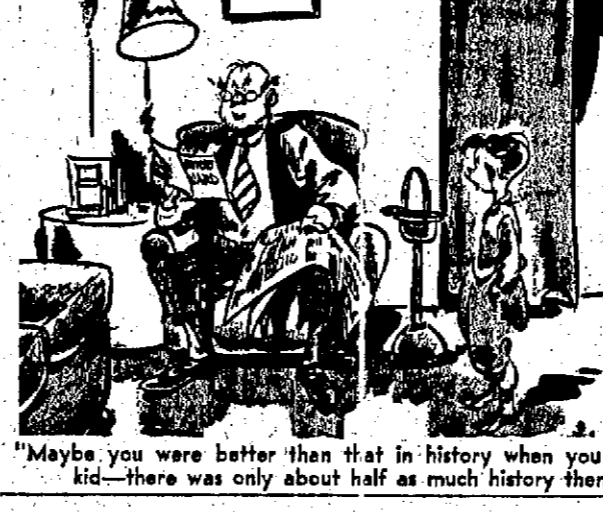
