Q. What kinds of wood are best suited for use in an open fireplace? G. K. W.

A. Ash, oak and elm among the more common woods make the best firewood. Dogwood, hazel and poplar are others that burn well without producing many sparks. Firewood should be dry, but not too dry.

Q. Which is the smallest capital city in the United States from the standpoint of population? P. W. E.

A. Carson City, Nev., with a population of 2478, was the smallest capital, according to the 1940 census.

Q. In what states are the chief cigar-producing areas? W. M. S.

A. Approximately half of all the cigars made in the United States are produced in three counties of North Carolina. Virginia produces one-third of the total, leaving less than 20 per cent for all other areas.

Q. Where was Mary Queen of Scots buried? G. R. T.

A. Her embalmed body lay for five months unburied and then was laid with great state and reverence in Peterborough Cathedral. In 1612 it was removed to King Henry VII's chapel in Westminster Abbey, to a sumptuous tomb erected by her son, James VI.

Q. When should fruit trees be planted? T. H. A.

A. Fruit trees should be planted during the dormant season, during the fall or late winter months before growth starts in the spring.

Q. Is the mother of a soldier killed in World War II entitled to collect his terminal leave pay? L. N. N.

A. Terminal leave pay is payable to the next of kin only when the veteran dies after discharge. If he was killed in service the next of kin is not eligible.
