Convicted on Morals Charge, Dotti Paroled

Joseph J. Dotti, Jr., 29, who last Mar. 10 was sentenced to a 12 to 18-month term in Wisconsin State prison for assault with intent to commit carnal knowledge and abuse, after being found guilty by a circuit court jury here, was released from prison on parole Dec. 11. It was learned today. Circuit Judge Herman W. Sachtjen, who sentenced Dotti in a letter to the state parole board Oct. 25 said he had "no objection" to a parole and "in fact the court would recommend such action." Deputy Dist. Atty. William Coyne, who prosecuted the case, gave the board no advice as to whether the parole should be rejected or denied. Prison records indicate Dotti's conduct and cooperation at the institution had been "excellent." Under state law, Dotti was eligible to parole after serving half of the maximum sentence or two years, whichever is the least. Half of his maximum sentence is nine months. He served nine months and one day.

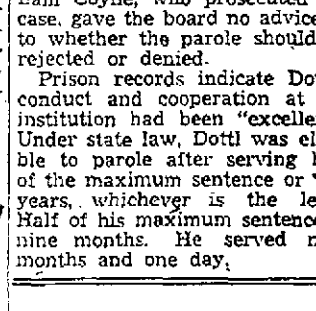

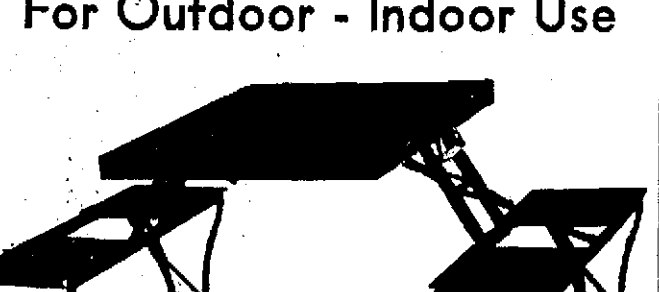
