AN ORDINANCE
FILE NUMBER 240 (1)
By Committee of the Whole:
An ordinance to create Section 3.01
and subsections (1) and (2) thereof, of

The City Council of the City of Madison
ordinances of the City of Madison of ordin as follows:

1. Section 3.01 of the General Ordinances of the City of Madison is created to rend as follows:

3.01 Organization of City into Administrative Departments. (1) Departments Created. The City of
Madison is organized under the City
Munager plan of sovernment pursuant to the provisions of chapter 64
of the Wisconain Statutes and Charter Ordinance adopted by the electors
of the City of Madison on November 5, 1826, effective April 15, 1847. The
administrative services and functions
of the city under the City Manager
is hereby organized into six separate
depurtments as follows:

(a) The Depurtment of Finance
which shall be under the supervision of the Director of Finance and
shall be composed of the following
divisions: Assessing Division Treasury Division: Division of Accounting and Comptrolling; and Division
of Furchmeng.

(b) The Department of Public
Works and shall be under the supervision of the Director of Public
Works and shall be under the supervision of the Division of Sarsincer and shall be under the
supervision of the Health Commissioner and shall be under the
supervision of Public Health hursing; Division of Vital
Statistics and Recards; Division of OrContaglous Disasse Hospital and Division.

(c) The Department of Public
Health which shall be under the
supervision of the Health Commissioner and shall be composed of the
following divisions: Division of OrContaglous Disasses Hospital and Division of Public Health Laboratory
(d) The Department of Public
Barty which shall be under the
supervision of the City Manager and
shall be composed of the Orivision of
Pince the Division of Police; and the
Division of Building Inspection.

(e) The Departmen

Welfare and Shall be combosed of those city agencies involved in providing for relief and public welfare cases.

(2) Heads of Departments. The City Managor shall by appointment, transfer or designation provide for the administration of the city department as established in subsection (1) of Section 3.01 by department heads who shall be responsible for the operation of their respective departments as herein set forth:

(a) Department of Finance. The Department of Finance shall be superised by the Director of Finance who shall be appointed by the City Manager. The Director of Finance shull be responsible for the financial planning, reporting and control of the financial affairs of the city.

(b) Department of Public Works. The Department of Public Works shall be supervised by the Director of Public Works. He shall be appointed by the City Manager and shall be responsible for the planning, construction, managing, operation and minitenance of the streets, will-titles and physical properties of the city except as otherwise provided by law or ordinance.
