Live Stock

WEEKLY LIVE STOCK
CHICAGO, Dec. 20 (UP)—Some steers sold this week for 30.00 per 100 lbs., equalling the national all-time high set at the stockyards last week. But heavy cattle were scarce and bids ranged 50-100 higher. Good beef cows were 20.00-22.00; and canners and cutters closed 13.00-15.00. Fat hogs were 24.00-25.00. Sausage hogs were 21.50. Choice vealers ranged 30.00. Hog prices moved 75-100 higher, while sows were steady. The top was 27.25. Bulk good and choice 170-300 lb. hogs sold 26.40-27.00. Most 200-300 lb. sows were 23.00-24.00. Slaughter lambs bid cheaper at the first of the week but regained much of the losses on Wednesday. Good and choice lambs finished the week at 25 cents higher, but other grades of slaughter lambs and yearlings averaged 50-100 lower. Bulk good and choice wooled lambs sold 24.00-24.60. Lower grades mainly less than 23.00. Common to medium shorn lambs brought 24.00. Bulk good and choice yearlings sold 14.00-15.00. Bulk slaughter ewes sold 8.25-8.50; and good to choice 6.50-6.82 wooled lambs 20.00-21.00.
