ODELL REPORTED ON WAY TO COAST FOR JOB PARLEY

Yale Mentor to Confer with Washington Officials on Grid Offer.

SEATTLE, Jan. 13 (AP)—The finger pointed sharply at Howard Odell of Yale today as the new head football coach at the University of Washington, with the Times saying flatly he was the chosen man and the New Haven, Conn., register reporting Odell was Westward bound to confer with university officials.

Out on the hilltop where the university sprawls all the comment was "no comment."

Last week the Times said the choice had narrowed to Odell and George Bauer of Kansas. Today it submitted one from the two and came up with Odell after hearing from the University of Kansas that Bauer had signed a new four-year contract.

Harvey Cassill, director of athletics at the university, was en route home from the East and was expected to make his recommendations to Dr. Raymond E. Allon, university president, tomorrow.

Odell has a three-year contract at Yale but Robert J. Iciphith, athletic director there, said just week the coach was "free to leave" at any time.

Good Record

NEW HAVEN, Jan. 13 (AP)—During his six years as head coach at Yale, Howard Odell's football teams have won 36 games, lost 15 and were tied twice. The record includes four in a row over arch rival Harvard, and four in five over Princeton, the lone defeat coming last season.

Odell's 1944 eleven went undefeated, but was tied once.
