Middleton Rd. Crash Claims Are Settled

Five damage suits which resulted from an automobile accident on the Middleton rd. on Apr. 20, 1947, were settled for a total of \$15,750 in circuit court Thursday.

The cases stemmed from the accident in which Floyd Puttkammer, 22, and Ralph Freeman, 20, were killed in a two-car collision. The suits were brought by parents of the two men and the three persons injured in the accident.

**Two Dead, Three Hurt**  
Mrs. Agnes Puttkammer, 2446 Upham st., mother of Floyd, was awarded \$4,850 and Bert H. Freeman, father of Ralph, was awarded \$3,100.

Wendell D. Natvig, 24, of 302 N. Frances st., was awarded \$2,300; Daniel DiLoreto, 25, of 706 Seymour st., \$2,300, and Baeruth Luebke, 21, Route 1, Middleton, \$3,400. Natvig, DiLoreto, and Miss Luebke received injuries in the accident.

The defendants in the case were London and Lancashire Indemnity Co. of America, which is to pay \$15,000 of the total, and the St. Paul Mercury Indemnity Co., which is to pay \$750.

**Heard Together**  
The cases were being heard by Circuit Judge Alvin C. Reis when William J. P. Aberg, attorney for the St. Paul Co., moved to consolidate the case. Judge Reis granted the consolidation and a pre-trial conference ensued. As a result of the conference, the case was settled in open court.

Frank Lombardo, owner of Frankies tavern, 416 S. Park st., filed a \$109 claim at the city hall today for damages to his automobile which he said was struck Nov. 7 by a city truck near W. Washington ave. and Proudft st.
