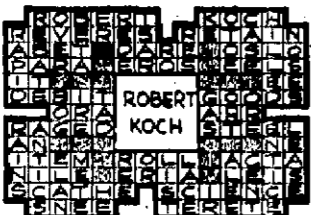

ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS

Q. What is a theremin? A. It is an electronic musical instrument, invented by a Russian whose name was Theremin. It resembles a radio-receiving set with an antenna at one corner. The player moves his right hand towards this antenna to get a high pitch and away from it to get a low pitch. The tone-quality and volume are regulated by means of a switch and by moving the left hand over a metal loop in the side of the instrument. A concerto has been composed for the instrument and it has been used in the concert hall.
