Cotton States Approve

New Insect Killer

WILMINGTON, Del. --- (U.P.) Eight cotton-producing states have gone on record as recom-mending the new insecticide; tox-aphene, for control of major cot-

ton insect pests. The Hercules Powder Co., which manufactures the insecticide, said the recommendations were based on results of extensive 1947 field tests by qualified entomologists in co-operation with cotton growers. The states which recommend toxaphene, or chlorinated camphenue, are Alabama, Arkansas, Georgia, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina

and Texas. Hercules said toxaphene is the first insecticide concentrate de-veloped for control of all harmful cotton insect pests. One of the major handicaps in cotton insect control was the necessity of using a variety of combination of poisons and control methods when more than one type of insect is
