

Week at the university The songbirds—70 students and alumnae of the Oslo Women's chorus—came dressed in white and carrying their black-tasseled student caps. They went away with the hearts of most of their audience.

The chorus attracted crowd that nearly filled the Wisconsin Union theater and offered a delightful concert, a whole evening of Norwe-gian music sung beautifully and with unaffected simplic-

The chorus, here for a 35concert tour of the United States, revised its program extensively and the non-Norwegian-speaking part of the audience had to reply on the music alone for its meaning.

But the interpretation was sensitive and the direction sure, and the audience understood pretty well, at that.

Among the loveliest of the music was "The Chalet Girl's Sunday Meditation," a poig-nant song of homesickness written by Ole Bull and sung touchingly by little Kari Fri-sell as soloist; the merry "Paul on the Hillside," and Ulfrstad's stirring "Psalm."

Other soloists were Gunvor Mjelva, who has a sweet, creamy voice; Eva Haxthow, cello-like alto, and Ragnhild Hygen, whose soaring so-prano trilled briefly in "Bird Songs." The chorus itself proved both a splendid solo instrument and a versatile

accompanist. For the final part of their program the chorus and its director, Agnes Brevig, appeared in colorful Norwegian costume to the audible delight of the audience.

The program also included avid Johansen's tuneful "Sonata in A Major", well played by two young Nor-wegians, Gunnar Saevig, con-certmaster of the University of Wisconsin Symphony or-chestra, and Audun Ravnan,
