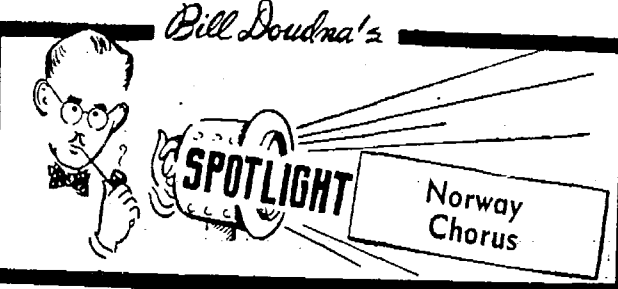

Cary Grant Turned Down 'Oscar' Role

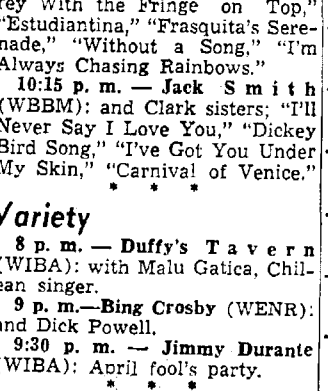
