Q. What is the chief source of funds which support public schools? I. J. M. A. Funds for the support of public schools are derived from taxes. The National Education Association says that the following figures represent sources of funds to support public schools: Local taxes, 65.63 per cent; state taxes, 32.99 per cent; federal taxes, 1.38 per cent. These figures were collected in 1943 and 1944 and are the latest available.
