



On the second round of hearts I put up the queen from my hand and North's jack fell. Now I did not reven have to ruff the spade. I took two more rounds of hearts, discarding a club from dummy, cashed the act of dumy, so ther two clubs, and ran the diamonds for the balance of the tricks. 


