Two Brothers Killed in Appleton Crash

APPLETON — (UP) — Two brothers were dead and their two children in critical condition today after their automobile crashed into a concrete culvert guard rail on Highway 47 near here.

The dead were Alvin Minten, 20, and his brother, Marvin, 19, Little Chute. The injured were Anthony B. Wyngaard, 19, who suffered a head injury, a broken leg and possible internal injuries, and Richard Van De Hey, 20, who received a head injury and a leg fracture.

Both Wyngaard and Van De Hey are from Little Chute. The accident occurred early Sunday, with no witnesses. The four were driving home from a wedding dance at Nichols, 13 miles north of here.

The car was smashed to pieces and a wrecking crew worked for an hour before the Minten brothers and Van De Hey could be lifted out. Wyngaard, the driver, was thrown clear. Parts of the car were hurled 102 feet. The motor was found 40 feet away.

Two Miners Sue UMW for Coal Strike Violence

LEXINGTON, Ky. — (UP) — Two Harlan county coal miners today filed civil suits in federal court, each seeking \$25,750 damages from the United Mine Workers of America (UMWA) on charges of "wrecking an act torturous" acts.

E. J. Williams and Richard Collins, employed by the Harlan-Wallins Coal Corp., based their allegations on occurrences during the recent coal strike. The men charged their lives had been threatened by UMW representatives when they attempted to do maintenance work.

The men asked \$10,000 each because they were "violently assaulted, humiliated, and emotionally and nervously upset, disturbed and distracted." They also asked \$750 "lost wages" for this period. In addition, they seek \$15,000 each for "wrongful and torturous acts by the union."
