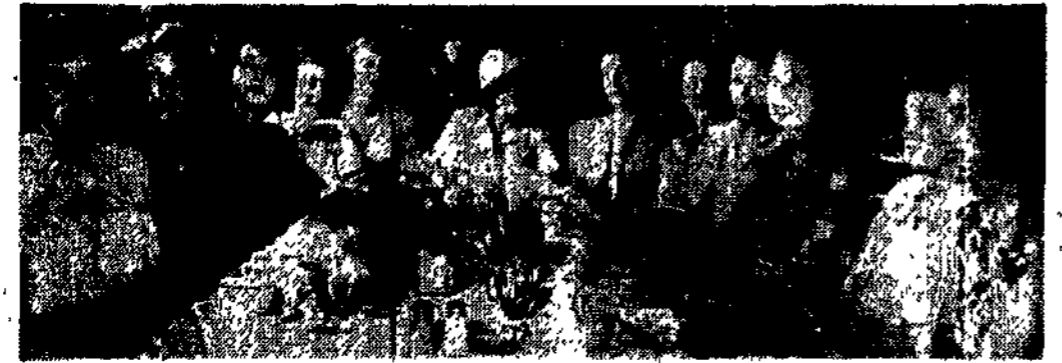

UN 'INVENTORY' URGED

NEW LONDON, June 14—(AP) A noted author and editor today suggested that this country take the first steps in calling for a "general inventory" of the United Nations. Norman Cousins, addressing the Connecticut College graduating class at commencement exercises, urged that a review conference, in which all nations would participate, be assembled. He said provisions for the meeting is included in the United Nations charter. President Roosevelt Park of Connecticut College presented 161 degrees, including one master of arts. There were no honorary degrees. In her annual statement at the exercises Miss Park announced that the college is about to proceed with the building of the college infirmary. She said funds had been raised by alumnae, undergraduates and friends of the institution during the last year of President Katharine Blount's administration.
