in a letter to develop at once "a voluntary allocation program . covering the requirements of the armed forces for steel mill prod-ucts and steel contained in manufactured products."

This indicated that the government's allocation power under the new draft law would not be used the industry could develop, in co-operation with Sawyer, a satisfactory allocation program on a voluntary basis.




