

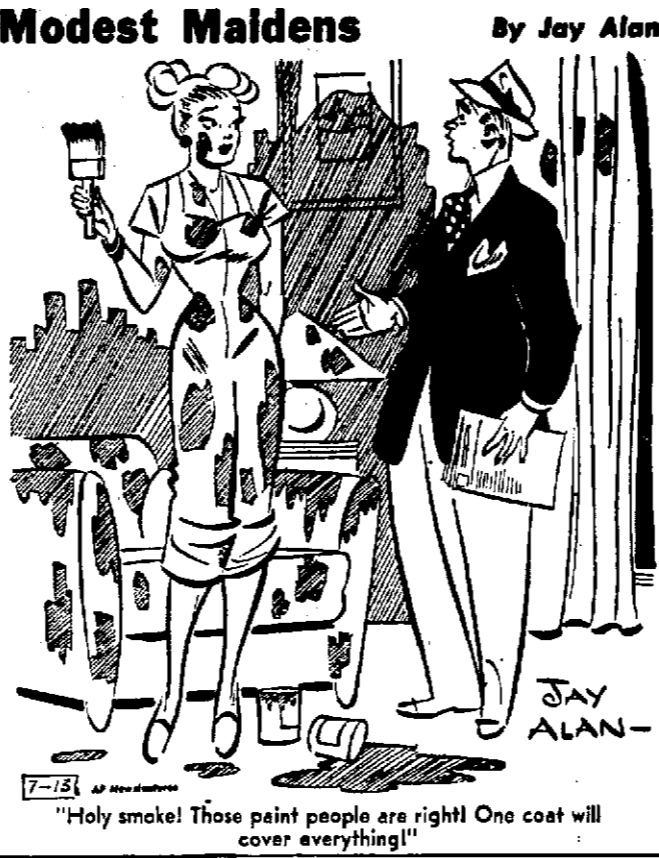

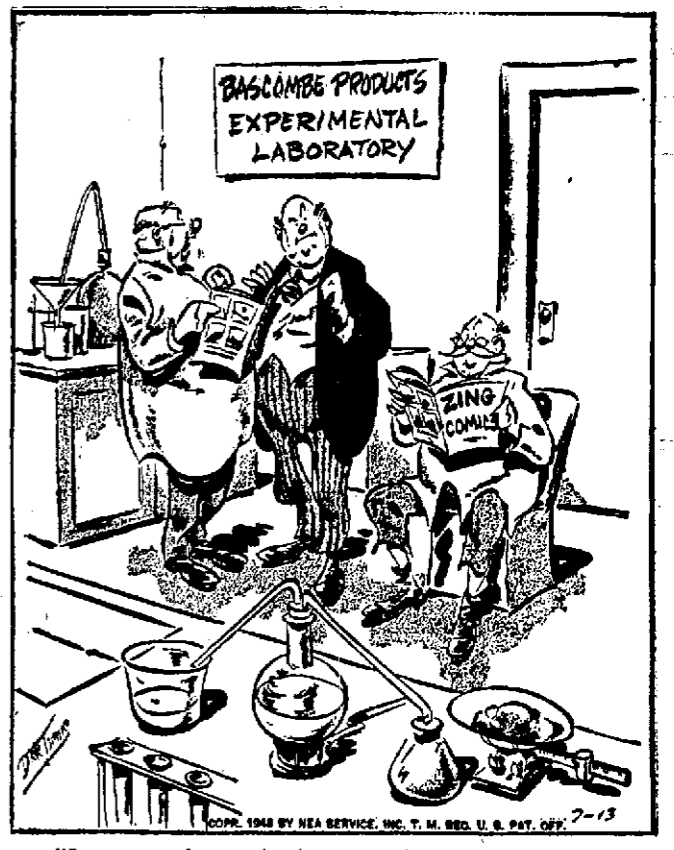

WHAT OTHERS ARE SAYING

ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS

Q. What does lex non scripta mean?—S. L. G. A. Literally, unwritten law. It refers to the common law, as distinguished from the statute or written law. Q. What cities of the United States have the most and the fewest automobiles per population? A. R. E. A. Figures for 1946 for cities above 100,000 population showed that Jersey City, N. J., and Boston, Mass., had the largest population per passenger car, the former 10.8 and the latter 10.3. On the other hand Miami, Fla., had one passenger car for each 2.4 persons. Q. What Presidents of the United States served without ever having been elected? G. D. R. A. Four Vice Presidents succeeded to the Presidency by reason of the death of the President and were not elected at the expiration of the term of office. They were: John Tyler, Millard Fillmore, Andrew Johnson and Chester A. Arthur. President Truman succeeded to the Presidency on the death of Franklin D. Roosevelt and has not as yet been elected to the office. Q. How long is the Appalachian Trail? F. P. B. A. The Appalachian Trail is a 2050-mile hiking route running along the crest of the Appalachian Highland between Mount Katahdin in Maine and the summit of Mount Oglethorpe in north Georgia. It is well blazed and identified by metal markers bearing the symbol of affiliated Appalachian Trail Clubs. The trail passes through a region noted for the deep blue color of the Appalachian Highland.

TREK TO CITY

THE CENSUS BUREAU reports that the farm population of the United States is down to 27,500,000 or 10 per cent less than it was in 1940. This comes about because the mechanization of agriculture is constantly releasing a larger number of people for city life. The trend has been underway ever since the Revolutionary War, but it is being speeded up now by such inventions as the mechanical cotton picker, the potato digger and the sugar beet harvester. The shift of population means that future depressions will have less chance to be cushioned by a return of city people to the soil. There simply won't be facilities on the farm to receive them. It means also that more attention should be given to the expansion of basic production in such things as steel, power, coal and transportation, so that industry will have the raw materials with which to supply an expanding number of jobs. This is a matter to which the President's Council of Economic Advisors might give serious attention. — St. Louis Post-Dispatch.
