

Truck, Bus Collide; 24 Escape Safely

CHICAGO (U.P.) — A Greyhound bus collided with an egg truck on Chicago's South side Saturday and burst into flames but the driver directed his 24 injured passengers to safety through an emergency exit.
The injured were treated for minor cuts and burns at South Chicago hospital. All were released after treatment.
The driver, James H. Madden, 25, was driving the bus enroute to Chicago from Cleveland, Ohio, when the crash occurred.
Madden was burned about the face and head, but he told the passengers to use the emergency door in the rear of the bus because the front exit was blocked by the fire.
Madden was the last to leave the bus.
He told police the bus crashed into the truck at an intersection just after he swung it around another truck. He said he did not see the approaching truck.
The fire started when the 90-gallon gasoline tank on the truck exploded and spread over the front of the bus and the cab of the truck.
The truck driver, Kenneth Arbuckle, 26, Indianapolis, was not injured. The 500 cases of eggs which Arbuckle was transporting to New York were completely destroyed.

Police Look Into Judge's Dice Games

NEWARK, N. J. (U.P.) — Investigators Saturday looked into the possibility that P. James Pellicchia, Jr., Newark's beau brummel judge who embezzled \$657,000 from his father's bank, may have lost a large portion of the money in dice games with an elite circle of politicians.
He claims to have lost it all on the horses.
Speculations, whose speculations stunned this city, was reported by intimates as having lost as much as \$60,000 and \$70,000 in a single dice game. The games, according to the reports, were attended by an exclusive circle of politicians, jurists, and lawyers.
Pellicchia, who readily confessed embezzlement of the money from the family-owned Columbus Trust Co., had not mentioned the alleged dice games.
Pellicchia, who once was named "America's best dressed jurist," is in the city jail.

Moscow's endorsement, he said, followed Wallace's approval of the Soviet labor system during a 1944 visit to Siberia.
