

\$4,000 FIRE STARTED BY PLUMBER'S TORCH

A blow torch held used by a plumber was held responsible by firemen for a blaze which did damage estimated at more than \$4,000 to a house being constructed by Joseph Longo, of 271 Fance street, Stratford, on Sunnyridge avenue, Fairfield, shortly before 2 p.m. yesterday.

Mr. Longo said the blaze which destroyed the roof of the structure spread rapidly after paper around insulation in the one-story structure was ignited by the torch.

Centur and Tunxis Hill firemen found the entire roof enveloped in flames and smoke when they arrived and brought the fire under control within 15 minutes.
