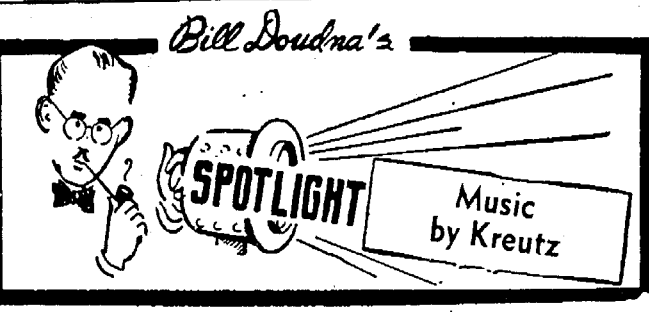

## U. S. Undercharged by Railroads Too, Official Replies

WASHINGTON—(U.P.)—A railroad industry spokesman said today there were many cases in which the government was undercharged by railroads for wartime freight shipments.

Pres. William T. Faricy of the Association of American Railroads issued the statement in answer to a charge by a house subcommittee that the general accounting office failed to catch some \$350,000,000 in overcharges on the government's wartime freight bill.

Faricy said the government's bookkeeping was a "one-way audit." If the shipments were for military or naval purposes, Faricy said, the government would be entitled to reduced rates. If they were for civilian purposes, he added, the government would have to pay the regular charges. He said "the question is one of fact and law in each case."
